

Demonstration of Forage corn varieties

The objective is to demonstrate and evaluate new forage corn varieties to producers and provide information about how they grow in Northeast Saskatchewan.

Corn breeders are continually making progress in developing cultivars with earlier maturity. Improved cultivars are released on an annual basis, making a demonstration like this an important tool for producers when deciding whether to grow corn and to select varieties. Corn production costs are high but because the crop can be used for winter grazing, harvest costs are very low. Information on relative yield of corn with alternate crops for winter grazing will provide growers with important information about this practice.
